

# European Day of Languages quiz

*(1,2 oder 3)*

**No. of people:** min. 15 students

**Length of activity:** 30 minutes

**Materials:** 10 plastic balls for each student, 1 bag for each student, beamer, computer, prize for winner(s)

**Preparation:** Name each corner of the room: A, B, C or D (write in huge letters on paper and stick onto wall). Provide balls (or similar item for counting correct answers) and bags (for collecting balls)

**Goal:** The main goal of the activity is to teach students about languages in Europe while having fun. The goal for the student is to get more answers right than anybody else in order to win the prize.

**The game:** The presentation containing 10 questions with 4 multiple choice answers is shown to the students and the questions are read aloud by the coordinator of the game.

The students need to choose an answer and, then, go to the corresponding corner of the room. Once all students have chosen an answer the correct answer is revealed and the students who got it right get a ball.

The winner is the one who collected most balls. Most of the time there will be more than one winner.

**Note:** feel free to alter the powerpoint presentation and to use other facts.
